

Admission for Applicants with Disabilities

All Gulf Coast College students accept issuance of and review a copy of the college catalog during the admissions process.

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Each campus provides a number of special facilities and services for disabled individuals who are qualified for such services by meeting established academic and technical standards requisite to admission and participation in a program of study. The physical facilities available for disabled students include disabled student parking and convenient accessibility to classrooms, laboratories, the Library/Resource Center, student lounge, restrooms, and all support service areas at the college for those students confined to a wheelchair.

Students with a qualified impairment of sensory, manual or speaking skills may be assisted with the provision of auxiliary educational aids within the limits of school or outside agency resources. Auxiliary aids include interpreters or other effective methods of making orally delivered materials available to students with hearing impairments. The school expressly allows for third-party payment for auxiliary aids and services from agencies such as rehabilitation services and/or charitable organizations.

Additionally, the school has a grievance procedure and has designated the Campus Director to function as the “Section 504 Coordinator” to assist affected students and employees who have a discrimination complaint regarding handicap issues and to coordinate campus compliance efforts.
